Snapshot of the Conference

About the Plant Visit

The Bangladesh Steel Re-Rolling Mills Ltd., commonly known as BSRM is South Asia's largest importer of ferrous scrap. Every year, it imports more than 1 million tonnes of scrap. Understanding the operation and technology of a high-volume scrap handling facility will be a significant draw. On September 22nd, delegates will have the opportunity to visit the production facility and scrap yard to examine the plant's technological advancement.



Objectives

- To gain a better understanding of Bangladesh's steel production.
- To learn about the operations and technological innovations of South Asia's largest scrap handling facility.
- To assess the performance potential of ferrous scrap in the Electric Induction Furnace (EIF) route steel production.

Introduction to BSRM

BSRM, Bangladesh's leading steel manufacturer, is one of the most prominent corporate houses in the country. Among its many other pioneering steps, it is the first to introduce an EMF-tested grade 500 rod, the first to pass 5 million cycling loading fatigue testing in the United Kingdom, and be certified to global standards. BSRM always looks into the need of the customers for which over the years it brought innovative products and services – like the production of a 50mm dia bar, especially for the deep pilling requirement of Padma Bridge.



BSRM's specialized products are also designed to meet the specific needs of the construction industry.

Today, BSRM is the country's largest steel producer, with 7 production facilities and an annual melting capacity of 1.8 million tonnes via the induction furnace route.




