# Introduction

Indian economy has seen on a strong recovery in post pandemic scenario which has now gotten disrupted by the inflationary concerns for various commodities coupled with geopolitical tensions on account of recent war conflicts. The mining industry is one of the core industries in India. In India, mining has around 1.2x-1.4x multiplier effect on industrial production. As per Central Government's estimates, the national mining sector provides direct employment to more than a million people, thereby contributing to livelihood creation.

It has huge untapped potential and Government's persistent efforts and initiatives are likely to help develop it further. As the GDP of a country increases with rapid urbanization and industrialization, its mineral consumption also grows at a rapid pace. India holds an advantage in terms of cost of production, being among the lowest cost producer of steel and aluminium, due to ample mineral availability and access to cheaper manpower.

The auction of mineral blocks with pre-embedded clearances is another significant reform taken by the government. This is going to attract huge investments in the mining and metals sector which has the potential to make the nation self-reliant, reduce import bills and create livelihood opportunities in the mineral-rich hinterlands of India.

Massive investment is required in exploration and up-gradation of the technological ecosystem. Emphasis should be given on exploration to continuously augment the resource/reserve base of the country and harness existing resources through scientific and sustainable mining including beneficiation. The recent announcements by the Government focus on enhancing domestic production, incentivizing exploration, and bringing more investments through unrestricted transfer of mineral concessions etc. are a welcome recognition of the mining industry's role in "Atmanirbhar Bharat".
